Dr. Brewster discussed the COVID-19 data on the Health Department's Website. There have been 2,952 COVID-19 cases in St. Mary's County with 74 COVID-19 related deaths. Thirtythree percent of county residents have been tested with five record-breaking weeks of positive cases. There are Covid outbreaks at all three long term care facilities. She discussed the implementation of the St. Mary's County Health Department Patient Portal, a new Behavioral Health Screening Tool on the St. Mary's County Health Department website, and the recently approved vaccination and its distribution. She also reminded citizens of the Draft Community Health Assessment available for review and comments until December 18, 2020.
