The permit will be obtained through Planning and Zoning at a cost of \$20.00. Once the permit is obtained than the electrician can file for an inspection at the inspection agency he uses.
- 2) Electricians, Inspectors and Homeowners wanted to speak at the monthly board meeting will need to submit the subject to be discussed by email one week before the board meeting. This will allow the board to be prepared and have all parties involved attend the meeting.
