A motion was made by Dr. DeVitis, seconded by Mr. Russell, to have Mr. Densford prepare a letter to the candidate stating that they are in violation of the St. Mary's County Ethics Ordinance and to authorize the Chairman to sign the letter. Vote passed 5-0.

Financial Disclosure Review

The Ethics Commission continued their financial disclosure review process, asking Mr. Densford to prepare a letter to the commissioner candidate who failed to properly complete her financial disclosure form, and directing Ms. Gleissner to contact the remainder of filers with errors to have them corrected.

A motion was made by Ms. McClernan-Walz, seconded by Mr. Russell, to have Mr. Densford prepare a letter to the candidate stating that they are in violation of the St. Mary's County Ethics Ordinance and to authorize the Chairman to sign the letter. Vote passed 5-0.
