June 25 Commissioner Meeting Rollup

LEONARDTOWN, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) began their business meeting with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

The CSMC then presented commendations for <u>Virginia Quade</u> and <u>Corporal Andrew Holton</u> in celebration of their retirements from St. Mary's County Government.

For their main agenda items, the Commissioners <u>approved</u> the Proposed Ordinance to repeal and reenact Chapter 203 entitled, "Building Construction" and repeal Chapter 223 Article IV entitled, "Inspection Fees." They also <u>authorized</u> the request to schedule a public hearing on the proposed amendment to the St. Mary's County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan.

During County Administrator Time, the Commissioners took the following action:

- Reviewed future CSMC meeting agendas.
- <u>Approved</u> the Patuxent River Naval Air Museum Association's lease renewal and extension.
- <u>Approved</u> the Sheriff's Office request to reorganize the Booking Specialist position and the Civilian Security Specialist to the position Corrections Specialist.
- <u>Approved</u> the reorganization and position classification for the Department of Human Resources.
- Approved and adopted the 2024 Recreation and Parks Strategic Plan.
- Approved the letter to the Maryland Agriculture Land Preservation Foundation
- Approved the agreement to lease Unit H of 25470 Point Lookout Road Leonardtown, Maryland from W.M. Davis Development at Breton Marketplace, LLC for the benefit of the St. Mary's County Health Department.

The Commissioners then wrapped the meeting with Commissioner Time.
