LEONARDTOWN, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) participated in a joint meeting today with the Commanding Officer of Naval Air Station Patuxent River (NAS PAX) which included discussion on the Lancaster Park lease, Lexington Park's Sustainable Communities designation, redevelopment of Millison Plaza, and the Military Installation Resilience Study.
